The Heritage of London Trust is the only building preservation trust covering the whole of London. The Trust exists to preserve the best of the past for the benefit of all who love this magnificent and historic city. We achieve this by offering grants towards the restoration of historic or listed buildings and monuments that are in some form of community use.

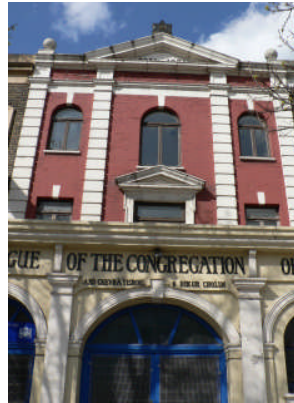


We have given out more than £3 million in grants to a diverse selection of restoration schemes across the capital, many in the poorest boroughs. Most of our heritage projects offer vital facilities for local communities, such as after-school programmes for children and services for the disabled and elderly. We focus our grants on specific aspects of the restoration work for example, conserving a stained glass window or plaster ceiling. Our grants are only paid out when restoration work is completed. By injecting money into these regeneration projects, we hope to encourage others to contribute to these historic buildings and support the community groups who use them.

We work closely with local government, charities and heritage bodies, such as English Heritage, to help community groups with advice on locating conservation experts to assist with their restoration

projects and how to raise match funding to ensure that projects are completed successfully.
