2pm – lecture entitled A Trip Around the Block: Tower Hill and its Neighbours.

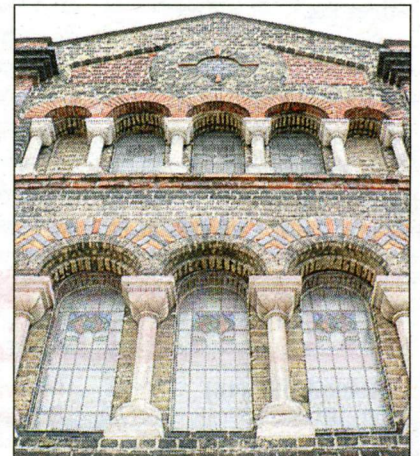
